FIRST AID, SAFETY AND FIRE TRAINING

COVID-19 Guidelines

The following guidelines are prepared under the guidance of the Australian Industry and Skills Committee (AISC) statement on the delivery of first aid training – 15th Apr 2020.

- First Aid training will be provided to essential services and delivered in the context of current social distancing and societal restrictions arising from the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Safetywave will ensure that training premises are sufficient in size to allow each person 4m², including the trainer. For group bookings, this will be ensured by the client.
- Safetywave will provide cleaning supplies and gloves to allow for equipment to be wiped down between use.
- Safetywave requests that trainees bring their own pen and clipboard to complete assessments.
- For the period of the COVID-19 pandemic, Safetywave will not allow trainees to breathe directly into a manikin. This will help minimise the risk of spreading the virus. Instead, trainees are to be assessed performing breaths to the side of the manikin.
- Trainees will position themselves into the recovery position.
- Trainees will complete bandaging on manikins.
- Any trainee who is unwell, or who is required to self-isolate, must not attend training and will be sent home.
- Trainees are asked to wash hands before attending.
